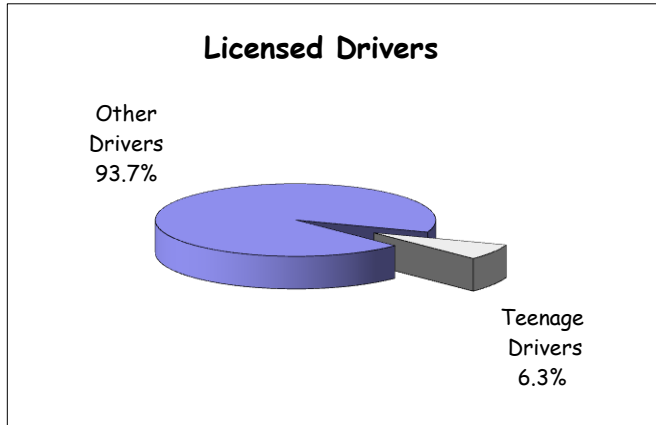


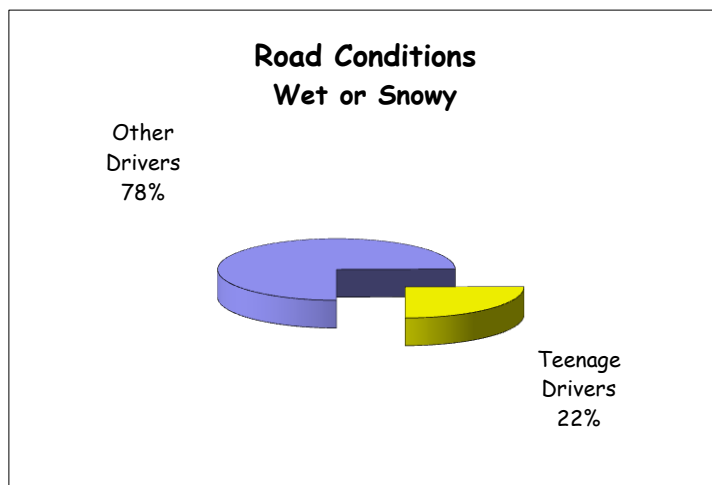
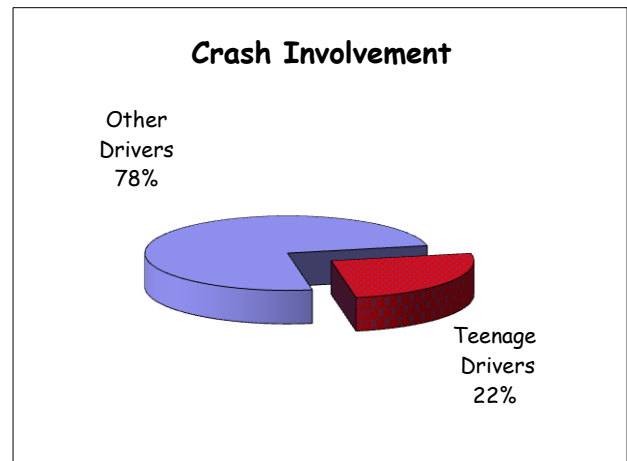
2010 Nebraska Teenage Drivers (Ages 19 & Younger) Compared to All Other Licensed Drivers



Teens account for 6.3% of all licensed drivers in the State of Nebraska.

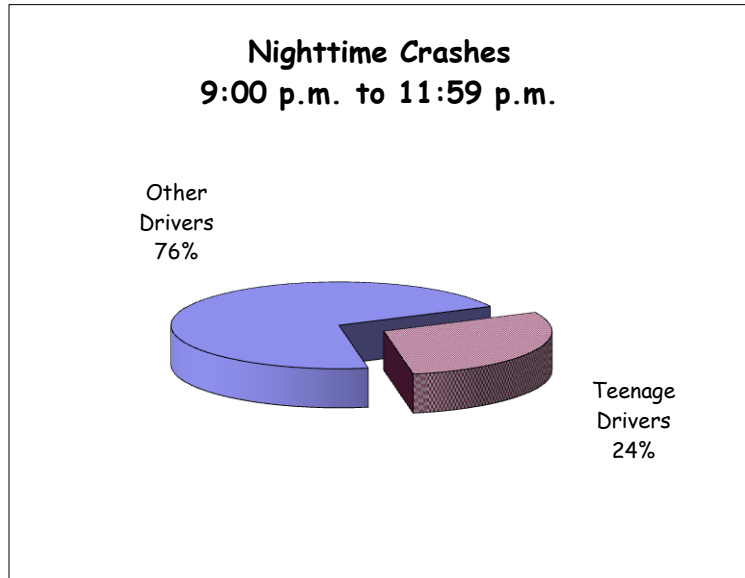
However, teenage drivers are overrepresented in motor vehicle crashes.

In 2010, teenage drivers were involved in 22% of all crashes, while only representing 6.3% of the driving population.



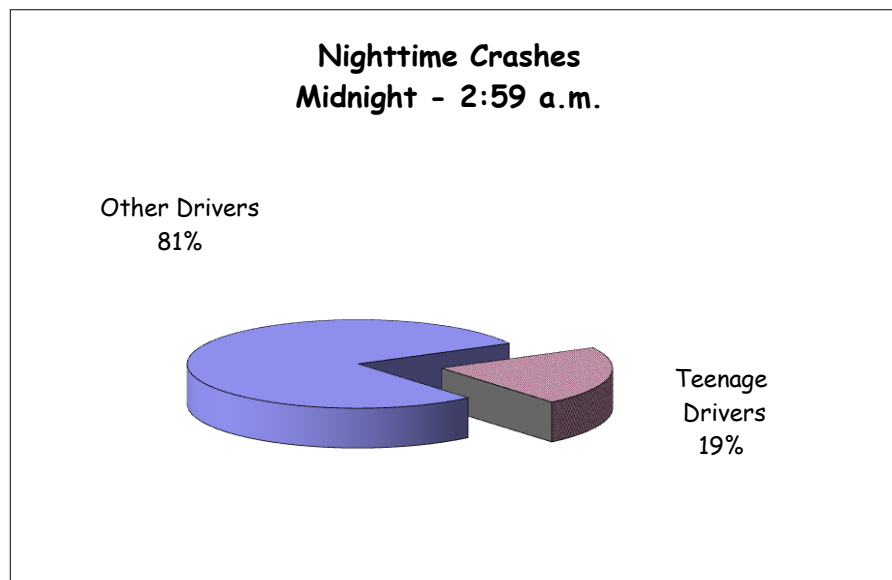
When wet or snowy conditions were present, teenage drivers were involved in 22% of all crashes.

Time of Day



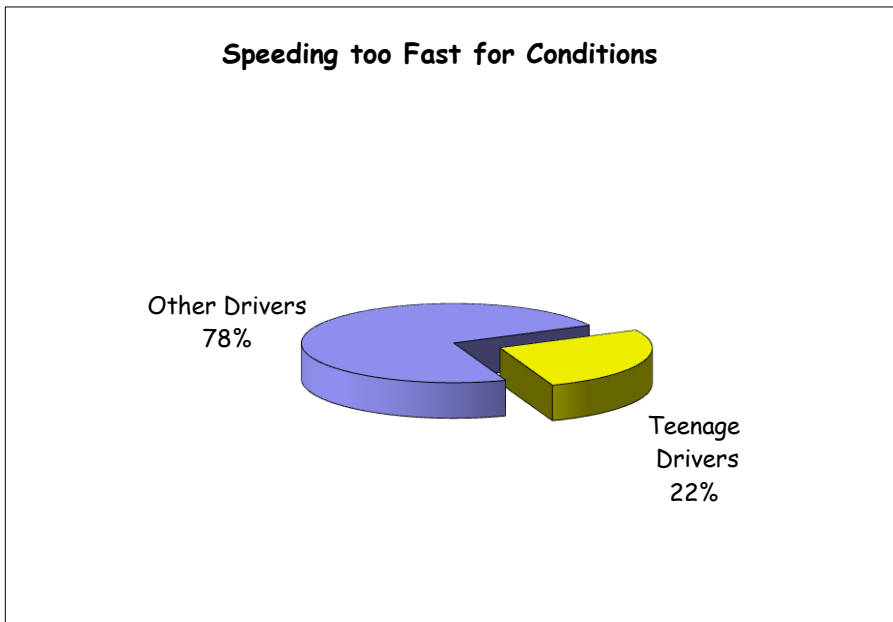
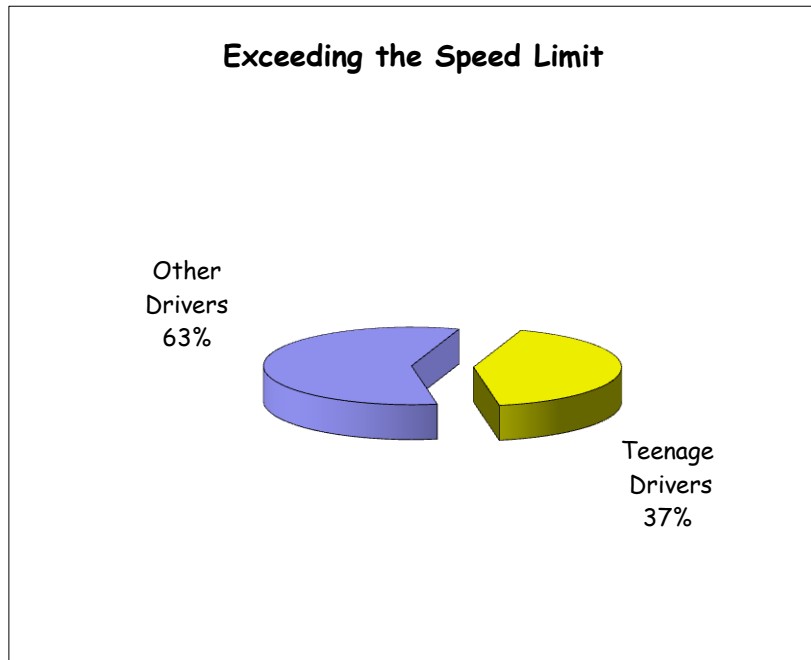
Teenage drivers were involved in 24% of nighttime crashes occurring between 9:00 p.m. and 11:59 p.m.

Teenage drivers were involved in 1 of every five nighttime crashes occurring between midnight and 2:59 a.m.



Speed

In crashes where "Exceeding the Speed Limit" was determined to be the major cause of the crash, 37% were teenage drivers.



In crashes, where "Speeding too Fast for Conditions" was cited as the major cause of the crash, 22% were teenage drivers.
