

2010 NEBRASKA TEEN DRIVER FACTS

Licensed drivers ages 19 & younger represent 7.4% of all licensed drivers (includes all LPD, SCP, and POP permits).

88% of teen drivers involved in fatal crashes were not using their safety belts.

TEEN DRIVERS (Ages 19 & Younger) WERE INVOLVED IN:

- 22% of all reported crashes
- 24% of all crashes between **9:00 p.m. and midnight**
- 19% of all crashes between **midnight and 3:00 a.m.**
- 24% of all crashes involved **cell phone** distraction
- 37% of crashes where **exceeding the speed limit** was the major cause
- 20% of crashes where **failure to yield** was the major cause
- 26% of all single vehicle **rollover** crashes
- 22% of crashes where **road conditions** were wet or snowy
- 22% of crashes where **speed too fast for conditions** was the major cause
- 27% of crashes where a **rear-end type collision** occurred
- 17% of crashes where **alcohol involvement** was a factor
- 16% of all crashes involving **female drivers** were teen females
- 14% of all crashes involving **male drivers** were teen males
